**Tuesday 13th January**

Ken Merry of the Institute of Advanced Motorists was our first speaker of the new year and we were very pleased that our meeting was so well attended by members as well as visitors who had come along to hear him explain how natural ageing can affect our driving skills.

He stressed the importance of having regular eyesight tests, seeking medical advice about any condition or new medication that we may be taking to make sure we're safe to drive.

Many modern cars are fitted with safety features and Ken encouraged us to make good use of these as well as perhaps going on a Mature Driver Review - as we all get into bad habits!



Ken explained the 2-second rule. This is a simple way to maintain a safe distance from the vehicle in front, by using a fixed marker such as a road sign; you recite "only a fool breaks the 2-second rule" after the car passes the object, if you reach the same object before finishing the phrase you're too close and need to drop back.

We should also keep up to date with the Highway Code and any changes to driving regulations, Ken suggested that this was probably best read online as the latest version is always available.
