

Gardening news – thanks Annie for passing this on....

As the Christmas season approaches, give some thought to growing your own bulbs for indoors. Amaryllis are guaranteed to give a stunning display. Here are some guidelines:

- Soak the roots and lower section of the bulb in tepid water for 24 hours before planting.
- Use a good loam and leaf mould compost.
- About half the bulb should be left exposed after planting.
- To initiate growth, bottom heat is important. Move to a sunny windowsill when the buds have formed.
- Use only tepid water.
- For Christmas flowering a minimum temperature of 18 °C needs to be maintained.
